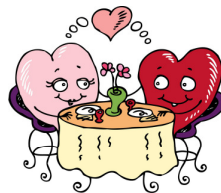
**Open Gym:** We are still holding open gym on Tuesdays at 6:00 pm-8:00 pm every week in the Family Life Center. Everyone welcome!
