The church council and properties KMA decided that due to the high cost of repairing the chimney by tuck pointing and making sure it doesn't leak, it would be better to tear it down, seal the roof completely, and put those dollars toward a new high efficiency boiler. Our current boiler is between 70 and 80% efficient, the new boiler will be 96% efficient. This will mean years of energy savings for the church. Over the next few weeks the roofing crew will be tearing down the old chimney on the north side of the roof, but the new boiler won't be in for approximately 2 weeks. This means there will be no heat for the Sunday school wing. Parent's, make sure that you send your kids to Sunday school with appropriate clothing.
